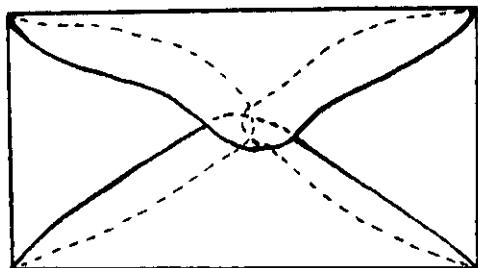

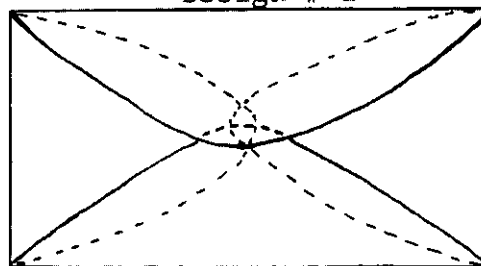
All stamps on envelope issues E-1 thru E-10 are embossed on the envelope.

 E-16 is a provisional issue due to change in postal rate, The 1/2d stamp was applied horizontally to the existing issue. Probably issued 30 July, 1953.
 E-17 did not generally appear until December of 1955. A few were issued by mistake from post offices in southwest Ireland in April of 1954.

Chart of Envelope Flap Designs Used

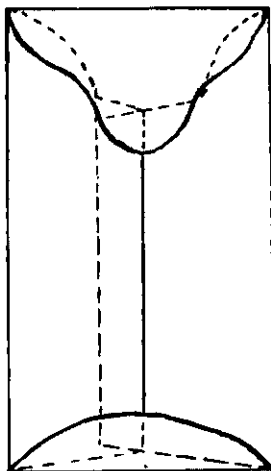

Information and illustrations are largely taken from Mr. Kennedy's "Check-List" of December, 1949. The January 1955 issue of L'Entier Postal (in French) containing an official list issued by the Postal Administration of Ireland agrees substantially with the Page 52 (R-4) previously issued information. 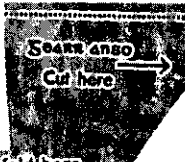

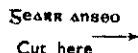

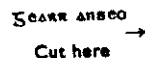
